Bruce Fite began his professional music career at the age of 21. He has shared the stage with National recording artists such as The Katinas, Justin McRoberts and Big Daddy Weave. Bruce has also performed at many local and regional church and school events, and he teams up regularly with FM 90.3 WJTL for various concert events. He has also been featured in the line up of Dutch Wonderland's Christian Family Fest* in Lancaster, PA.

The music of Bruce Fite is best described by the words – Versatility & Fun. The ever popular tunes from his 2006 CD, "Don't Put Your Cat in the Washing Machine", "Bread and Cereal", and "Photosynthesis" have kids and parents tapping their toes and learning important lessons along the way.
